



- 1 Ring: Deck team assembles at entrance of the control room on Car Deck. Engine room fire team assembles at the scene of fire. Assisting as instructed by Chief Engineer and mate.
- 2 Rings: Fire team assembles at the scene of fire on Car Deck
- 3 Rings: Fire team assembles at the scene of fire in Passenger Cabin
- 4 Rings: Fire team assembles at the scene of fire on Texas Deck

ABANDON SHIP



The general alarm bells give seven short rings followed by one long ring, supplemented by the same signal on the ship's whistle



The general alarm bells give one long ring & one short ring for at least three times, followed by one short ring for boat 1 & two short rings for boat 2, supplemented by the same signal on the ship's whistle
