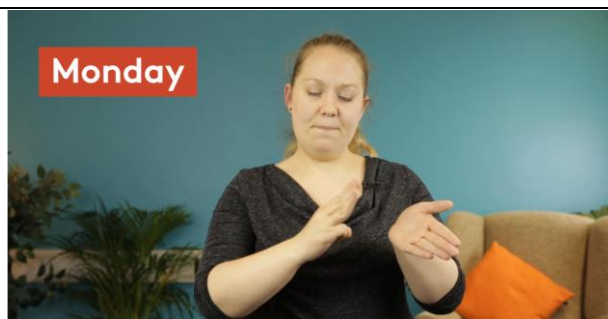

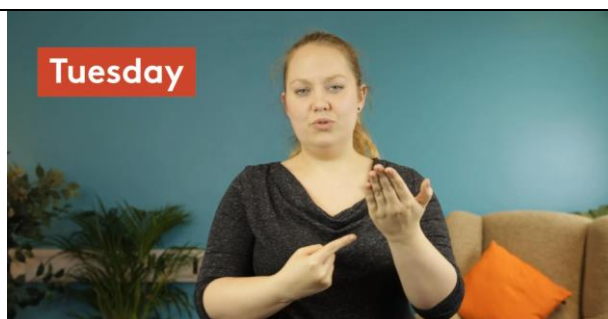
Monday



How To Make This Sign

- **Monday:** Double tap the sign for 'M'.

Tuesday



How To Make This Sign

- **Tuesday:** Double tap the sign for 'T'.

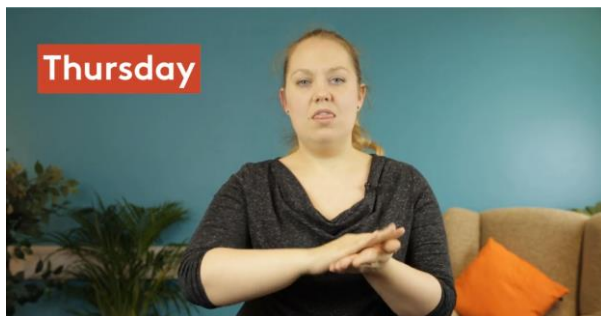
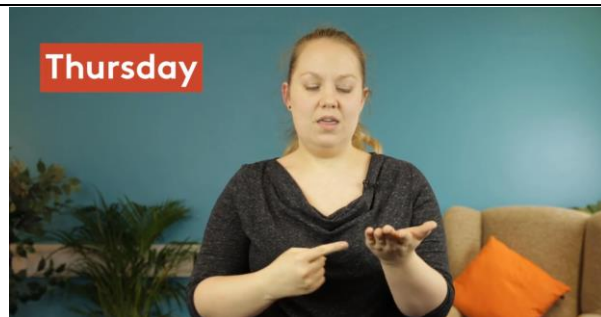
Wednesday



How To Make This Sign

- **Wednesday:** Double tap the sign for 'W'.

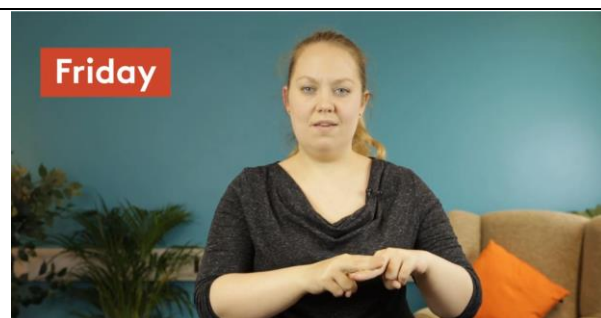
Thursday



How To Make This Sign

- **Thursday:** Fingerspell 'T' then 'H'.

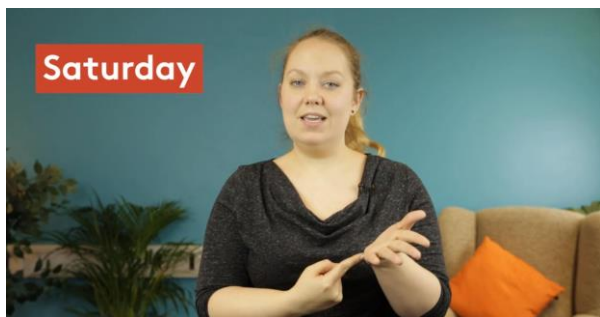
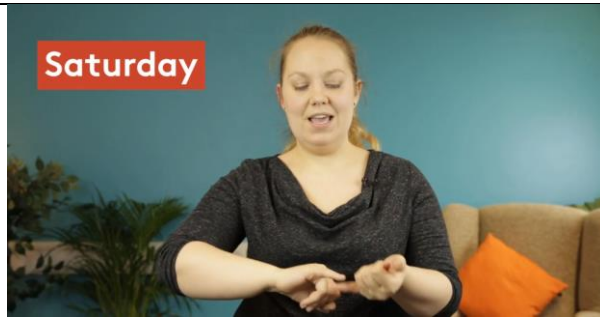
Friday



How To Make This Sign

- **Friday:** Double tap the sign for 'F'.

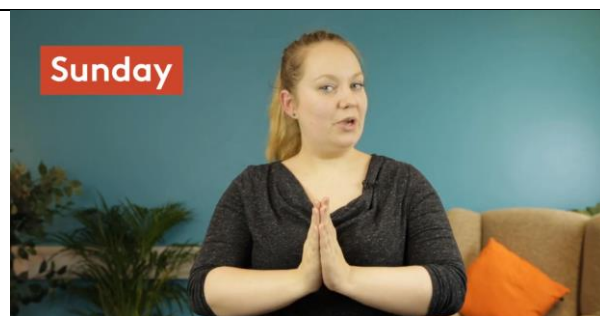
Saturday



How To Make This Sign

- **Saturday:** Fingerspell 'S', 'A', and then 'T'.

Sunday



How To Make This Sign

- **Sunday:** Gently clap/tap your hands together twice (almost like a prayer).
