If there is a hurricane, I will watch the news for evacuation notices or other instructions from local authorities. If there is an evacuation order, I will stay with my family in another state. If there is no evacuation order, I will secure my home and stay inside until the storm passes. I will buy extra food and water for when there is an emergency. After the storm, I will stay inside the house until I know it is safe to go outside. |
