	Minimum age of entry	Educational Requirements
Three-year Training Courses General, or for Children or Psychiatry	16	In most cases, five years Secondary Education to O.G.C.E. standard, with two "O" level passes or the passing of the O.G.C.E. educational test.
Two-Year Training Courses General or Psychiatry	18	A good general education or special education qualifications.
