

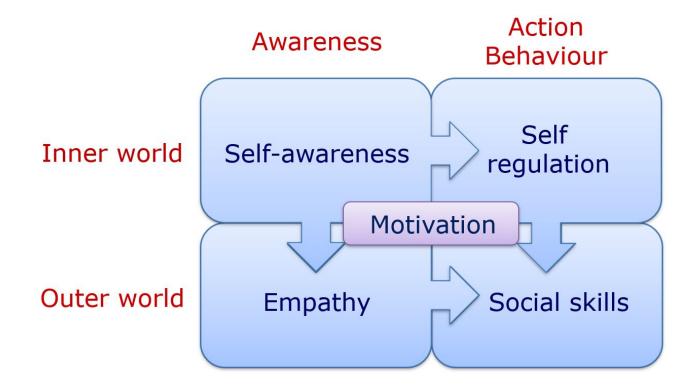
Emotional Intelligence
