A mood board or an inspiration board, is a fashion design tool that is used to convey a theme or a mood. The mood board should include a variety of visual references, which should include images, textures, fabrics, fibres, and anything that inspires the designer or reminds them of how they feel in regards to their design. The board should also relay the design's colour story and other elements like line and shape.
