Module 6 - Activity 2: Find Credible Sources

One of the best ways to see some success as a cryptocurrency miner is to stay informed on recent developments in the field. However, this can be hard, due to the amount of outdated and incorrect information that is on the internet.

Before you start mining, take a few moments and look for credible sources about the software, hardware and advances in cryptocurrency mining you should watch for in the future. Make a list of about five or six sources that you feel you can trust.

For example, major newspapers and outlets such as "The Guardian" or "Business Insider" tend to use reliable sources in their reporting. You can typically find two or three cryptocurrency sources you can trust in articles published by those outlets.
