Red




How To Make This Sign

 Red: Make an 'r' shape with your index finger and put it on your chin, just under your lips

(**Tip:** To help you remember think of red lips – bring your 'r' shape to the lips).

Orange



How To Make This Sign

• **Orange:** Squeeze an imaginary orange (fruit).

Blue



How To Make This Sign

• **Blue:** Use your index and middle finger to rub your opposite wrist where you can often see blue veins.

Green



How To Make This Sign

 Green: Rub up the inside of your arm with the back of your hand from the wrist to the elbow.

Yellow



How To Make This Sign

• **Yellow:** Fingerspell the letter 'Y', and tap/stroke it twice whilst mouthing the word yellow.

Purple



How To Make This Sign

• **Purple:** With your thumb and index finger on your dominant hand pinch the top of the index finger on the other hand creating a 'P' shape and flick twice.

Pink



How To Make This Sign

 Pink: Similar to purple but instead of flicking your finger, flick your nose.

Black



How To Make This Sign

• **Black:** Pull your fist downwards across your cheek.

White




How To Make This Sign

• White: Point and stroke where a white collar would be on a shirt.

Brown





How To Make This Sign

• **Brown:** Stroke the back of your arm from the wrist toward the elbow.

Grey






How To Make This Sign

• **Grey:** Sign the letters 'G' and 'Y' and mouth the word 'grey'.

Gold, Silver & Bronze



1. The signs for Gold, Silver and Bronze use an open hand gesture to show a 'sparkle'

How To Make This Sign

For each of these signs, you need to sign the first letter (i.e., G-S-B) and then open your hands wide as if there's a spark/glisten.

- Gold: Fingerspell the letter 'G', then open your hands wide to show a sparkle.
- Silver: Fingerspell the letter 'S', then open your hands wide to show a sparkle.
- Bronze: Fingerspell the letter 'B', then open your hands wide to show a sparkle.
