You have been asked to create an interactive legend in Excel using no VBA.


## MODULE REQUIREMENTS

- ▶ Insert form control check boxes.
- ▶ Link the check boxes to the spreadsheet.
- ▶ Link the chart to the results

## HINTS

For form control properties, right + click > Format Control....

## STEP-BY-STEP INSTRUCTIONS

Click Steps	Screen Shots
<div>1. Open Module 9 Interactive Legend</div> <div>2. Select the Data (Example) tab to get started.</div> <div>3. In cell A8, type =A2. Drag down two more cells to get the countries in the data set.</div>	



Click Steps	Screen Shots
7. One at a time, change the label of each checkbox to reflect its associated country. (Hint: Right + click the check box > Edit Text)	
8. Link each check box to its adjacent cell under the Is Showing column. (Hint: Ctrl + click each checkbox. Set its linked reference in the formula bar.)	
9. In cell B8, type =IF(\$I8,B2,NA()). Drag to the right and down.	
10. With the cell range A8:H9 highlighted, insert a new line chart. Toggle the check boxes to ensure everything is working.
