### Reading the notes

An Apostrophe is used to signal a 'high' note: D \_ normal, D' \_ high D

The symbol \_ indicates a note should be held for an extra beat

|DDD| has the same beats as |D\_D| or |D\_\_|

The numbers in red represent fingers
